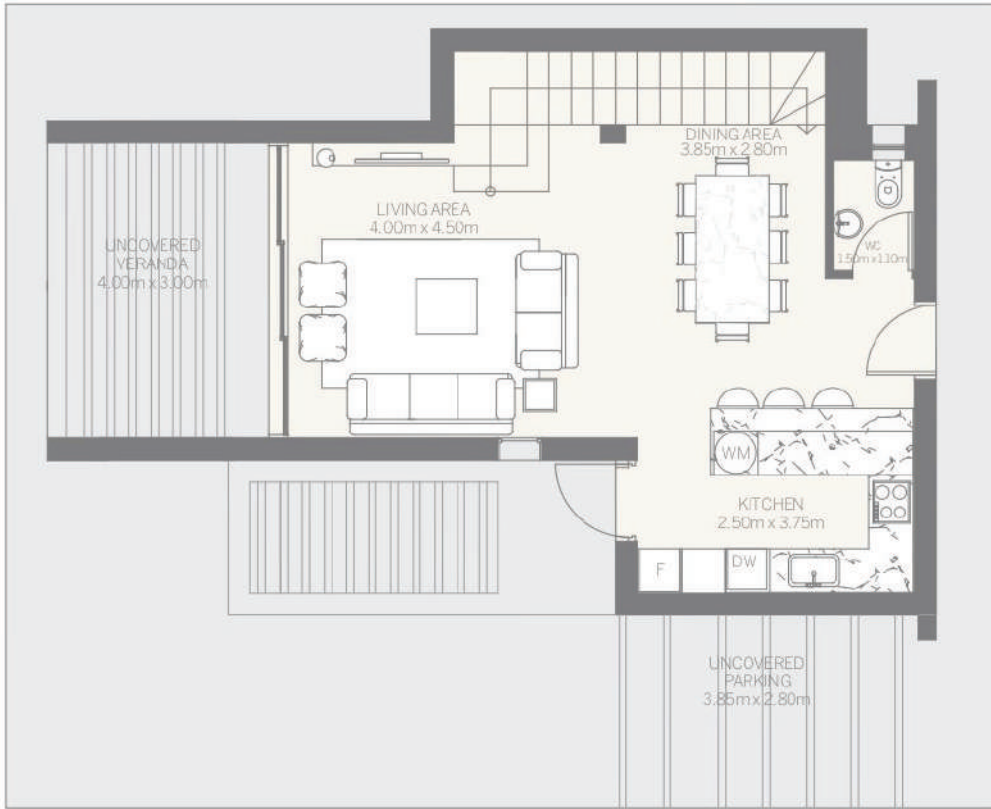




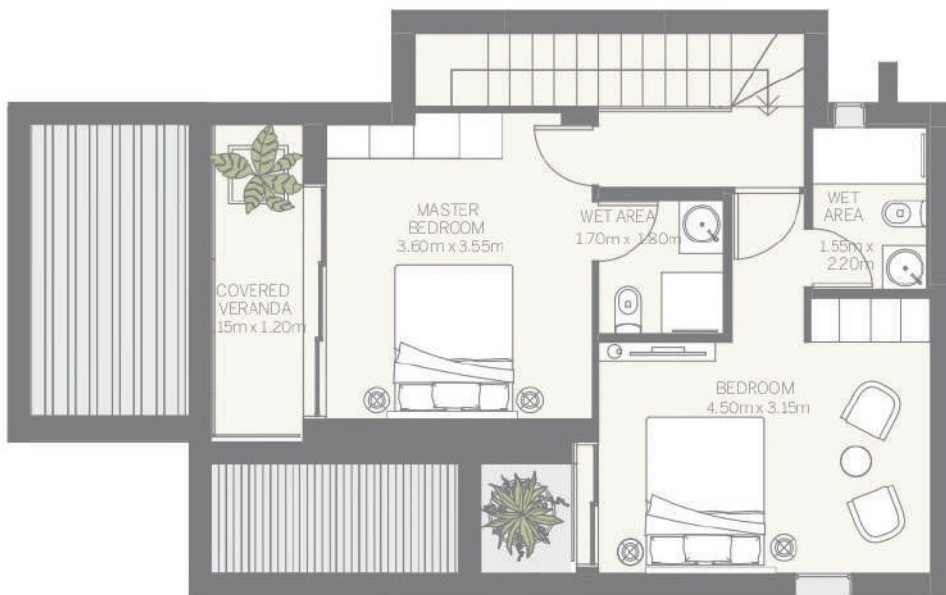
VILLA TYPE A

GROUND FLOOR

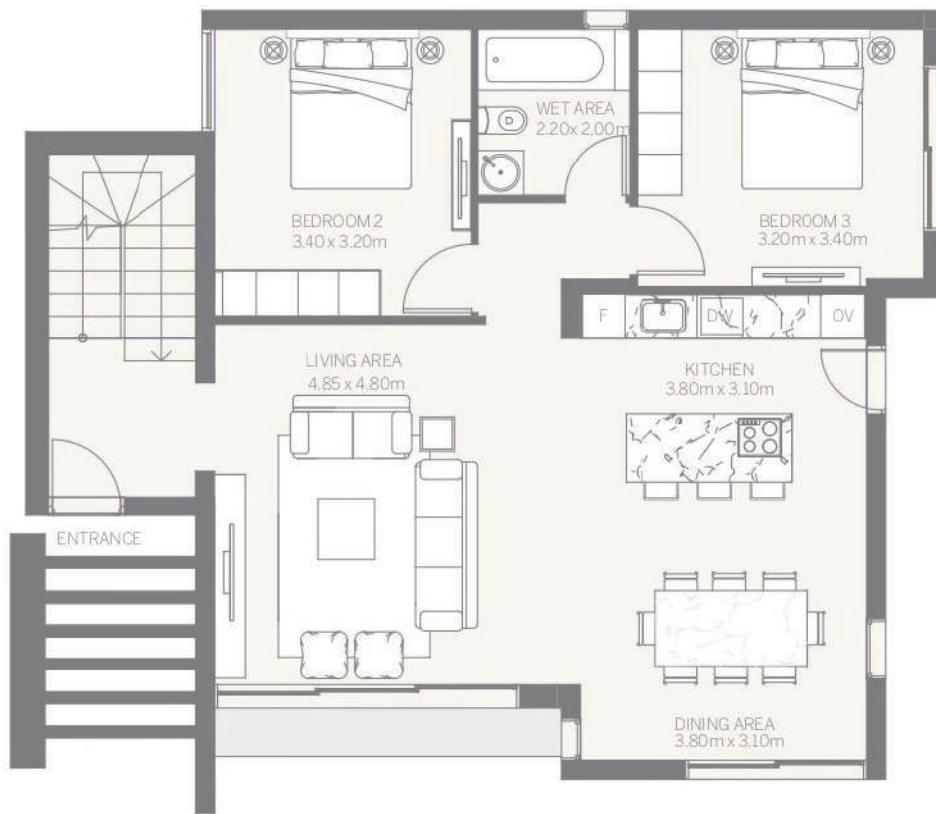

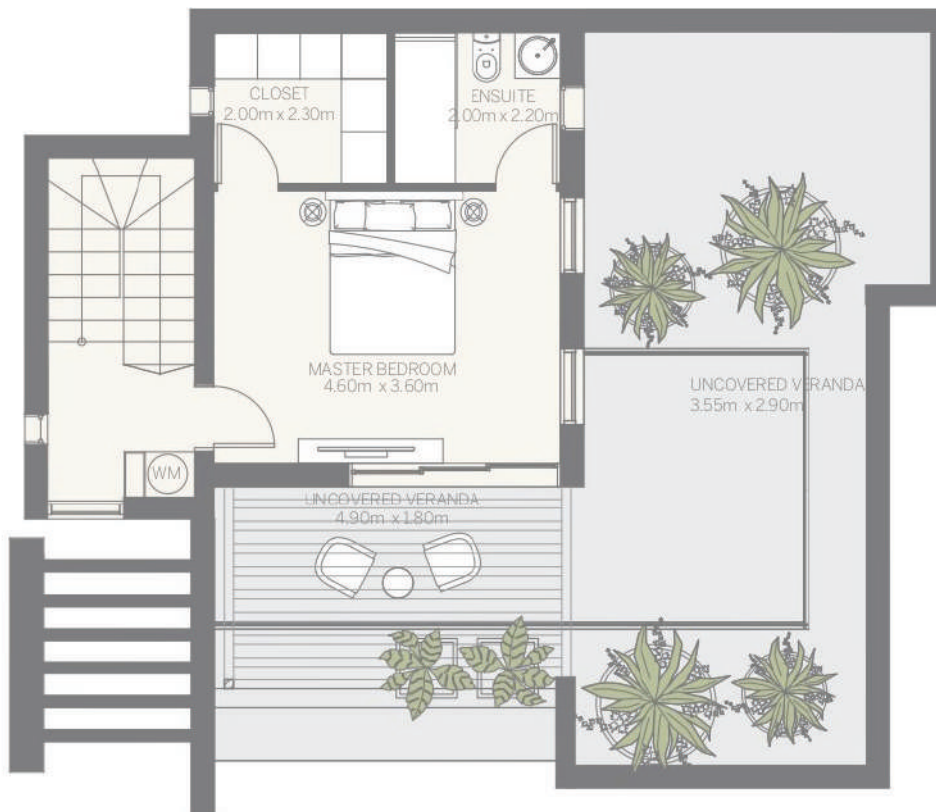
VILLA TYPE B

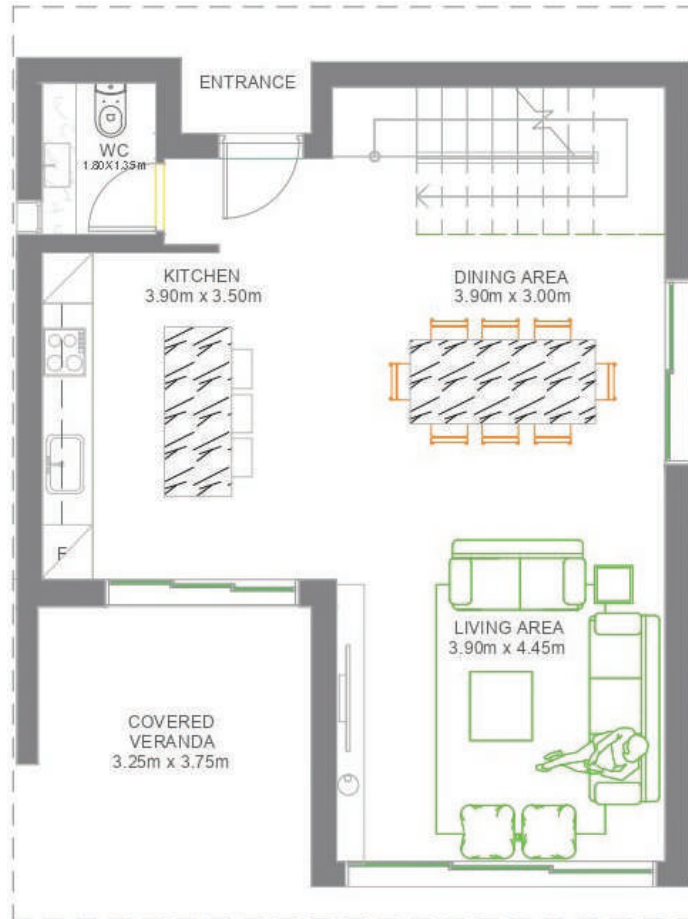

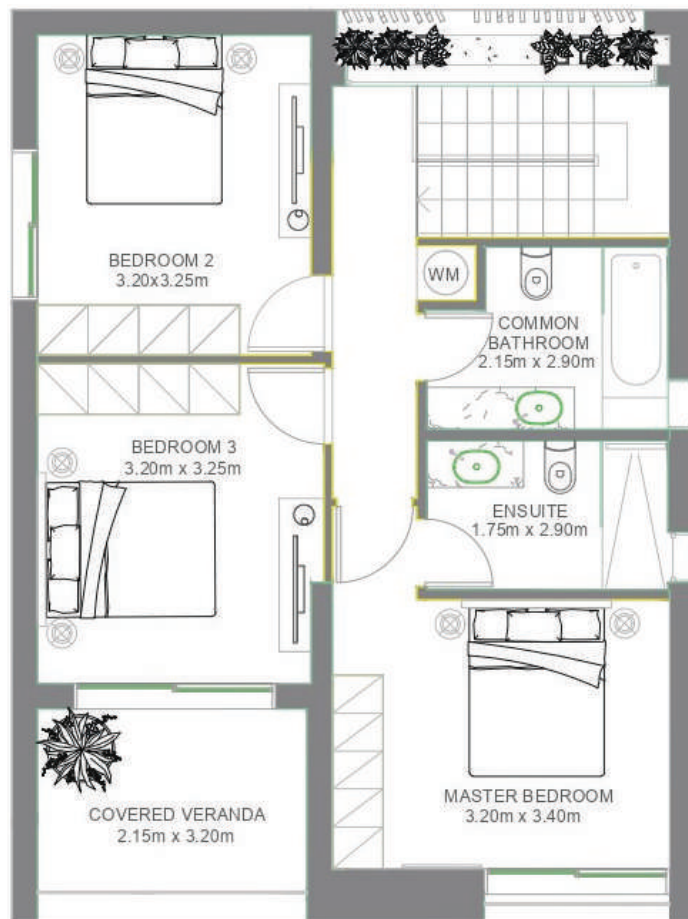
The combination of traditional materials with an ultra-modern edge has resulted in enduring designs that fully exploit their spectacular setting.

FINISHES

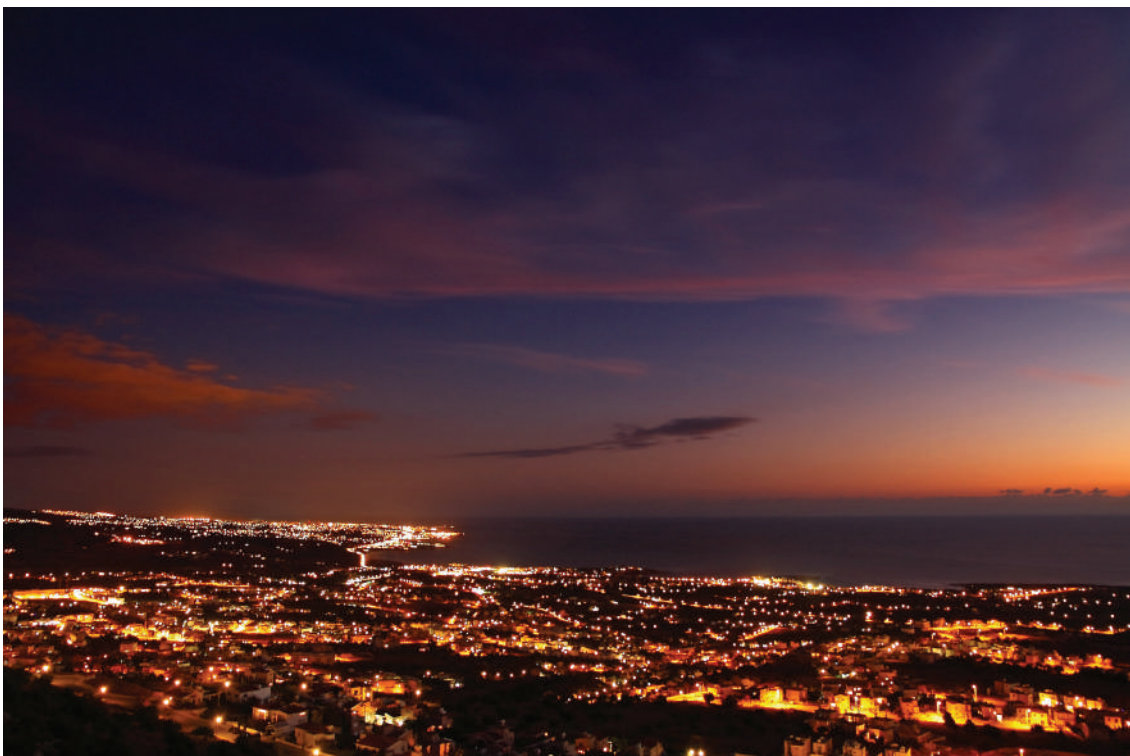
The high quality finish has been carried through to the interior spaces, with marble, parquet and high gloss kitchens. Large terraces are ideal for indoor/outdoor living, enabling residents to enjoy an al fresco lifestyle, while glass balustrades ensure uninterrupted views.





PEYIA

Peyia is a town in the Paphos District of Cyprus, situated mainly on the steep slopes of the coastal hills inland from Coral Bay, at the southern end of the Akamas Peninsula. In the town centre, is a town hall, church, police station and several shops, restaurants and banks. Due to its hillside location many parts of the town offer incredible views over Coral Bay and Paphos.



The plots rural location promises tranquility and seclusion, yet it's just a few minutes' drive from Peyia village. There is a wealth of local amenities on the door step, including banks, public and private schools, supermarkets, cafes and restaurants.

Coral Bay, with its blue flag sandy beaches and excellent array of cafes and restaurants is just a five minute drive and the quaint fishing port and sea caves of Agios Georgios, which sit on the edge of the Akamas National Park, is also just a five minutes away.





The area offers an abundance of sporting temptations, including horse riding, cycling, hiking on the nature trails and every type of water activity you could imagine.

Only 17km away of an impressive full concept shopping mall, with entertainment venues, cafes and restaurants.



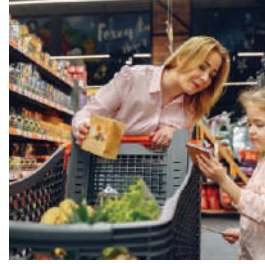

LOCAL AMENITIES



SEA CAVES

The Peyia Sea Caves are a unique place of natural beauty and of geological and biological interest. The area is also known as Kantarkastoi and is characterized by coastal formations, caves, stone lodges and engulfment.



AYIOS GEORGIOS MUSEUM

The museum is home to the ruins of two Christian Basilicas and a bath along with commendable mosaics of animals, all dated to the 6th century.



PAFOS ZOO

Pafos Zoo is the biggest licensed zoo in Cyprus. Set in a unspoiled natural environment, it is one of the island's leading tourist attractions. It is home to an extensive variety of birds and animals from every corner of the planet.



NATURE PATHS

The forestry department has developed a large number of trails in and out of the national forest, they all offer opportunities to see many wonderful and natural sights.



AVAKAS GORGE

The gorge is a popular hiking and adventure destination with dramatic canyon, waterfalls and wildlife. It is one of the natural wonders in the Pafos region and one of the best places to visit for people who enjoy walking and nature as it offers magnificent views.



EDRO III SHIPWRECK

The ship lies on the sea rocks at an angle of 11–12 degrees near the sea cave area. Together with Germany's CIMEXTA Vessel Salvage Company, the task of safe removal of all diesel, hydrocarbons and marine pollutants on board the vessel, and making the hull watertight was awarded to a Cypriot marine salvage company.



PAPHOS



The contemporary city of Pafos is just a fifteen minute drive away. Pafos is home to a great extent of the island's rich cultural heritage including a medieval fortress, frescoed tombs and remarkable mosaics. Almost an open-air museum in itself, UNESCO added the entire town to its world heritage list. In addition to its rich culture, the Pafos area offers a wealth of amenities and facilities that cater to every need. It offers a large selection of restaurants serving both traditional and international cuisine, stylish cafes, entertainment complexes, boutiques and international stores. The private schools offer a well balanced education based on the English National Curriculum.



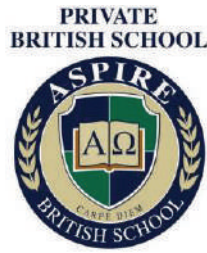

GESY is a full-coverage healthcare program for all citizens of Cyprus and holders of a permanent residence status. This new system gives people a choice between the services of any doctor or other healthcare professional in the private or public sector.

For decades, the Cyprus health sector has been primarily known for its standards of excellence, with its highly trained and internationally experienced professionals, specialised medical services and globally renowned research. The majority of its medical professionals are educated at top-tier universities in the UK, Greece, Western Europe, the US and Russia. That is why healthcare in Cyprus is recognised by the World Health Organisation to be on a par with developed countries.
